In the PYP, it is believed this is how students learn best while supported by teachers, parents, and the community in constructing meaning.

The Learner Profile attribute, **KNOWLEDGEABLE**, states: We develop and use conceptual understanding, exploring knowledge across a range of disciplines. We engage with issues and ideas that have local and global significance.

**SHOW and TELL:** Is there something you know how to do really well? Teach someone how to do something new. Draw or take a picture of your adventure!

**VISIT:** A museum, a library, or any place you like. What is something you learned during your visit? How can visiting new places help you become more knowledgeable?
