



Inquiry Adventure: January 2020

Inquiry is the basis for everything that students do in an International Baccalaureate School. In the Primary Years Programme (PYP)*, inquiry is structured, purposeful, and engages students actively in their own learning.

The Learner Profile, **COMMUNICATOR**, states: We express ourselves confidently and creatively in more than one language and in many ways. We collaborate effectively, listening carefully to the perspectives of other individuals and groups.

Parents can support their child's understanding of this attribute by taking an Inquiry Adventure with their child.

Step

1: Take an Inquiry Adventure with your child this month!

READ: Read a story, then tell someone about what you read. You can do this in any language!

TELL: Tell someone about a time you were excited, scared, or nervous. Use expression and feeling words to communicate what happened. Try this in more than one language!

PLAY: Play a game of charades and use your body to give clues to your partner. Take turns guessing what the other person is showing.

WRITE: Write a letter to someone, communicating a special message with pictures and words. You can do this in any language!
