Health & Safety Updates

If your child has a positive COVID case please immediately report it to the <u>CPS</u> <u>COVID Tracing line by clicking here</u>. Once reported, CPS will then take action in investigating and determining the need for quarantine. They will then communicate with the school. Please also email me at <u>kgibson@cps.edu</u> so I can take immediate actions.

The district communicated with all parents prior to Labor Day that travel quarantine rules have changed. For international travel and domestic travel outside Illinois the following steps are to be taken for unvaccinated youth to support community safety: upon return to Illinois quarantine for 7 days with a COVID negative test (or) quarantine for 10 days without a COVID test taken. Please email both your homeroom teacher and our attendance coordinator, Martha Maldonado , <u>mrmaldonado@cps.edu</u>, if your child will be in a travel quarantine.

We have already launched the collection of copies of vaccination cards for 7th & 8th graders eligible for vaccination. In the case of a CPS issued quarantine, 7th and 8th graders that have proof of vaccination, and are asymptomatic, will be allowed to continue coming to school in person.

Students' physical and immunization records are required by schools to ensure a healthy and safe environment for all our students. They are due by October 15, 2021. The physical and immunization requirements are as follows:

- Physicals (Required for Pre-K, Kindergarten and 6th Grade)
- Immunizations
- -DTap, Polio, MMR, Hepatitis B, Chickenpox, HIB and Pneumococcal (Required for Pre-K and Kindergarten)
- -Tdap and Meningococcal (Required for 6th Grade)


